Thank you for your generous outpouring!!

Many of our housing needs have been met. THANK YOU! Below is a list of the items we still need.

CD player, book shelves, kid size play table, area rugs, flatware, glasses, broom, mop, laundry baskets, steak knives, cutting knives, coffee mugs, small table or desk, globe, king or queen bed (there are usually 1-2 kids in bed with us, especially now), pillows, bath towels, washcloths, bath mats, lamps, basic toolbox with tools.

"An update by Gary Peterson on Wednesday, March 2, 2011 at 11:08pm My dear friends, thank you for your outpouring of love. My family is overwhelmed by your generosity!

These are just the major categories. There are at least a hundred things we probably need and aren't even thinking of. Everyone has a specialty that is unique to them. A dear friend is ham radio operator and offered to retrieve this specialty equipment from my truck. Another is a photographer and offered a unique service to us. Homeschoolers are trying to rebuild all the curriculum and resources we lost. In crisis mode we can't even think of these kinds of things but they mean so much! If you have something that is special to you, we accept. We have learned that now is the time to say, "Yes. Thank you." Many of you know that Sarah and I are very independent and private people. We are humbled by this and in many ways it is difficult to any sense of control taken from us by this experience. We place ourselves in your hands.

Housing: We are currently staying with my in-laws. It's a bit cramped in this 3 bedroom ranch but that's where the kids feel safe and that is a major priority now. The kids are still having moments of anxiety and concern that even this house will burn down. :-(

We are going to rebuild the home and that is expected to take 6-12 months so we will be renting some type of temporary single family home in the Elkton/Newark area. If you have some opportunities for this need, please contact us*

*(we are emotionally and physically spent. My church (Vineyard Christian Fellowship at the Barn - Landenberg, PA) as well as my coworkers Kenny Dunn and Dave Lawrence of NCC*EMS have offered themselves as coordinators for the relief efforts. If you have anything to offer to meet our needs, please contact them. They are coordinating efforts and reducing duplication. Thank you so much)

Clothing: We are still finishing up our immediate clothing needs. Thank you for the many donations! We still have a long way to go to replace what we lost. Having five kids and expecting # 6, we stored anything that could be passed down. We not only lost the clothes in current circulation that fit, but also at least 40 large 30 gallon bins with labels such as "Boy 3T Summer" and such. We had a similar collection of shoes as little feet are constantly growing. They were in constant rotation and a huge loss. We are trying to rebuild this.

Vehicles: Both my Ford Excursion and Honda Odyssey were officially totaled. We are still arranging immediate loan/rental. Now that there will be 8 in the family, we are looking to replace the vehicles with: An 8 passenger Honda Odyssey for the whole family and a Honda Civic or Accord for my commute. If you have, or know of, an opportunity or blessing for us in this area, please contact us*

Furniture: We are currently with the in-laws so there is no where to put anything. We are exploring opportunities for storage. We don't really know where we're going with this yet since we don't even know what the new house will be like. We can be certain of needing the standard furnishings: 1 king bed, 2 bunk beds, crib, toddler bed, numerous dressers, tables, pots, pans, bedding, etc. If you have a way to bless us in this area, thank you. Please contact the coordinator and it will likely be placed on reserve for when we need it.

Finances: Thank you so much for the gifts of money so far! I would love to give you all extremely specific ways to bless us because it is so much more personal. I will try to do that as much as possible. With so many unknowns, your gift of money will certainly be used fill the unexpected needs. We have insurance coverage to replace the house and lost property but we are concerned that it will be far less then the value of what was lost. Insurance companies aren't exactly in business to give money away and we are likely to not remember everything no matter the effort.

Food: There is a meal rotation established for those who wish to bless with a meal. This certainly relieves some stress so we can focus on logistics / insurance / etc.

Toys: Hey, we've got kids and toys are must:-) If you would like to bless our boys and girl with a gift card, or money, specific toy, we thank you. They know it's not from Sarah and I and are voicing their thanks to us for all their "friends who love us."

Words cannot express our love and gratitude for you all. Thank you. Thank you so very much.

She was told the address was 112 Silchester Drive in Surrey Ridge Elkton, Md.

She immediately knew it was her son & daughter in laws , which they had just moved into two weeks prior.

Gary & Sarah previously lived at 588 Leeds Rd. for over five years before purchasing their home in Surrey Ridge. They have resided in Elkton for years, although he is employed in Delaware. Sarah is pregnant with their sixth child and her due date is Sept.4th.

The entire Peterson family is devastated by the loss suffered by Gary & Sarah but thankful that no one suffered injury or loss of life.

It is truly a miracle they escaped with the clothes on their back! Singerly did any outstanding job with extinguishment.
